

#### NOTES

The Choco-leles is the name of the ukulele group that grew out of the weekly jam sessions held in the Walter Baker Building at 1231 Adams Street, Boston, MA 02124, starting with the first sing-along and play-along on the night of the Super Blue Blood Moon in January 2018.

The songs in this compilation are updated from Choco-lele's Christmas Songbook 2018, to include those songs intended for the annual Holiday Stroll in Historic Lower Mills on Saturday 30th November 2019. Where there are multiple versions (keys), the one chosen for the Holiday Stroll will be shown in black ink and ordered on the right in the table of contents.

The main changes are 1) corrections (of texts, chords, and chord placements), 2) replacement of previous song sheets with chords that are easier for beginners and better layouts, and 3) additional songs of Hanukkah Oh Hanukkah and Mele Kalikimaka. I present this compilation as a gift for my group and my students.

I'd like to thank the pioneering creators of ukulele song sheets for their dedication and generosity, making these sheets freely available online, easily found and some with functionality to edit, transpose, etc. Alphabetically, they are as follows:
